And no garage would be complete without the proper flooring and cabinetry, so Alternative Surfaces will be there to show their stuff. They will also show a West Coast Choppers-built custom motorcycle.

And, get this, Eastside Distilling will be on hand providing samples of its spirits in the Garage, and if you like what you taste, you can purchase a full cocktail in the Man Cave next to Eastside. If only you could light up a cigar (you can't).

The Garage is just one of the great features at the PIAS, along with 600+ automobiles from the world's car makers that make this year's show a can't miss event.
