- Ford Motor Company will bring a number of heavy hitters including the Bronco Raptor, Mustang Mach E, the new Maverick and workhorse Super Duty Truck, winner of the prestigious 2024 North American Truck of the Year Award.
- The **Kia EV9**, Kia's all-electric, 9-passenger SUV, winner of the prestigious 2024 North American Utility Vehicle of the Year.
- **Buick/GMC** is showing its upscale **Envision** and **Envista**, along with popular GMC Trucks and SUVs such as the **Canyon**, **Acadia**, **2500** and the **GMC Hummer**.

- **Subaru,** in addition to those cuter-than-cute puppies at its main floor **Pet Adoption** event, will have a stellar lineup of its most popular vehicles, many which are so suitable to the Oregon lifestyle, such as **Outback, Crosstrek and Forester** all in the Wilderness trim level.
