How to Qualify!

- *The participants with the fastest 4 scores for each Friday, Saturday, and Sunday will be invited to play in the finals on Sunday at 3 pm!*
- To sign up, pick up a controller and start playing! If there is a line, write your name on the white board and a volunteer will let you know when it is your turn.
- Must use the equipment provided (N-64 Mario Kart; Cannot bring your own controller)
- Select the appropriate settings
 - 1 player, Time Trials
 - Any character
 - Luigi Raceway
- Can play up to 2 rounds at a time; only the second score will be recorded
- Must complete all three laps - the total time is what will be recorded
- Raise your hand and a PRGE volunteer will record your information and your time!

How to win!

- Best 4 times for each day (Fri - Sat) will be invited to return for the finals. (They will be alerted via email on Saturday evening.)
- Finals
 - The 12 qualifiers that return will race in 4 rounds of 3 players each.
 - The first place winner of those 4 races will compete in the final round!
 - 4th place: 2 Weekend Passes to PRGE 2026!
 - 3rd place: \$1,000
 - 2nd place: \$3,000
 - 1st place: \$6,000

Terms and Conditions:

- Must have a valid badge to the Oregon Auto Show. (Fri - Sat winners will be awarded a Sunday badge to return for the finals.)
- Tournament times will only be recorded during show times, with entries closing 15 minutes before the show ends for the day. Organizers has a right to close the tournament for anyreason.
- Participants must by 16 years of age or older. Participants under 18 must have a guardian present to win.
- Participants must adhere to the PRGE Code of Conduct. Anyone acting inappropriately or displaying unsportsmanlike conduct, the organizer reserves the right to disqualify them.
